SUNSET BLVD! at St. James Theatre

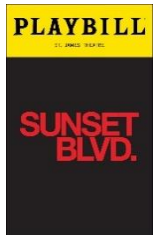

GYPSY at Majestic Theatre

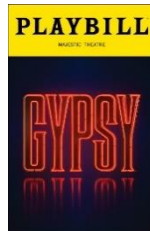

BOOP! The Betty Boop Musical at Broadhurst Theatre

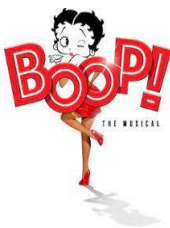

SMASH at Imperial Theatre

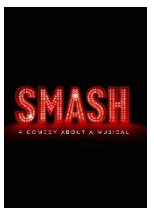
